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**Co-Chair Micki Sanderson called the special meeting to order at 5:05 pm**

**Special Meeting regarding a vote by the HHC to delay the demolition of the building structures/any changes to the property at 18 Elm Street, Hatfield MA**

At 5:45 pm on June 9, 2023, after much deliberation, the members of the Hatfield Historical Commission voted in quorum to issue a demolition delay on all structures and any removal of artifacts located at the 18 Elm Street, Hatfield, MA, property located in the Town's Elm Street Historic District.

Ed Lesko made a motion to vote to enact a one-year demolition delay on the properties at 18 Elm Street known as the Hatfield Barn and the Lowell Mansion. It was seconded by Cathy Belden Olson and all committee members present voted to delay any demolition of property and removal of artifacts at 18 Elm Street, Hatfield MA. Motion 1.

**Other discussion at the Special Meeting**

It was discussed that the Hatfield Planning Board should get involved to scope out a plan for the entire property.

Regarding artifacts associated with the 18 Elm Street property - discussion was had on the Town obtaining them for historical preservation utilizing Hatfield Historical Society funding or other Town funding to be determined.

Micki made a motion to adjourn at approximately 7pm and it was seconded by Cathy with all concurring. Motion 2.
