This is a message from the Town of Hatfield. As cases of the COVID-19 Coronavirus continue, the Board of Selectmen and the Board of Health feel it is important we take measures to protect our employees and residents to reduce the spread of the virus.

The Town Hall remains open with limited hours. Town Hall hours will be Tuesdays from 9am–1pm and Thursdays from 1pm–5pm. All parties wishing to enter the building will be required to sanitize your hands and wear a face covering of some type which you must bring with you. Only one customer will be allowed per office at a time. ENTRY and EXIT to the Town Hall will only be allowed through the side door closest to the new ramp. People are still encouraged to do as much business with the Town Hall offices via email, phone, online billing payment or using the drop box, which is located at the south back corner of the building. Parking is not allowed in the driveway as this is a FIRE LANE.

As we continue with Phase 3 Step 1, please go to www.mass.gov to be able to see all new guidelines set by Governor Baker. Playgrounds remain open, basketball hoops remain taken down at this time. All information gets forwarded to both the BOS and the BOH so that all boards are updated with the information and questions.

As of today, Tuesday, September 1, 2020 the state website shows that the Town of Hatfield has had 1 new cases, totaling 22 for the town, Please continue to follow the CDC guidelines and adhere to the 6' social distancing recommendations and if not able to do that you MUST be wearing a mask or mouth and nose coverage, wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds or use alcohol-based hand sanitizers.

The town will be providing updates every Monday evening as new information becomes available. Residents are encouraged to go to the town website and click on the CodeRed link on the home page and register to make sure you get all emergency notifications from the town.
